

## COMMUNITY CONSULTATION ON PROPOSALS FOR A REPLACEMENT WEST STAND AT ALLIANZ PARK

### Dear Resident,

Since 2013, Allianz Park has become a thriving hub of community, educational and sporting activity. During that time, it has become clear that the existing West Stand, which was built in 1964, has come to the end of its useful life. It is therefore proposed to replace the ageing stand with a new, modern stand which will build upon the community, educational and sporting success at the stadium.

The new proposed stand would deliver:

- Improved facilities for all sports users including, athletics, rugby, and community sport
- Further space for Middlesex University's Sport & Exercise Science department along with new health & wellbeing facilities
- Enhanced facilities to support Saracens charitable arm, the Saracens Sports Foundation, to further develop its award winning community programme
- A much better environment for stadium users and spectators, including vastly improved disabled access and facilities.

The proposed new West Stand will be similar in size and appearance to the East Stand. The maximum permanent capacity of Allianz Park will not exceed 10,500 (currently 10,000). As such, existing match day arrangements, including the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) and the maximum of 16 match days per season, would continue unchanged.

The plans will also include a proposal for one of the 16 matches to accommodate a one-off European Rugby Champions Cup game at Allianz Park. This would enable the capacity of the stadium to be temporarily increased to 15,000 for a maximum of one match a year

in the event that Saracens qualify for a home quarter final tie in the European Rugby Champions Cup. A bespoke match day travel plan would be in place to cater for such occasional matches.

Saracens has been committed to engaging the local community in the development, management and use of Allianz Park as we believe this is as much Your Stadium as it is ours.

We will be holding exhibitions to outline the current plans and seek your input. There will be members of the design team and senior Saracens staff on hand to answer any questions you may have so we would urge you to come and have your say.

The exhibitions are being held on:

- Thursday 10 November, 7pm – 9pm, Fez Lounge, Allianz Park
- Friday 11 November, 6pm – 9pm, Fez Lounge, Allianz Park
- Saturday 12 November, 9am – 11.30am, Olympic Bar, Allianz Park
