Our proposals

We believe customers could benefit from:

- A new second entrance and exit to the station
- More escalators
- Step free access from the street to trains
- More space to change between trains
- Improved fire protection and evacuation
- Removing the need for frequent crowd control measures
- Removing one of the remaining obstacles to future frequency increases on the Northern Line







Public engagement

STATION UPGRADE

- In October 2015, a public consultation was carried out to share the station design proposals and request feedback
- 1,744 responses received from residents, commuters, visitors, and local businesses
- 95% of respondents agreed there was a need for a capacity upgrade of the station

OVER-STATION DEVELOPMENT

- In January 2017, a public consultation was carried on proposals for the development above the proposed station upgrade
- 95 responses have been received from the public, nine from stakeholders
- Analysis of results in progress



Proposed Over-Station development



- Delivers 60-70 homes, maximising number of affordable homes
- Targeting 50% affordable homes across all TfL sites
- Camden development currently delivers a minimum of 35% affordable housing
- Activates local streetscape
- Retail space adjacent to new station entrance



Next steps

- March 2017 12 week value enhancement assessing current station design to deliver the most efficient design for the best value
- Summer 2017 Progress Over-Station Development design with planning submission targeted at the end of 2017
- Summer 2017 Second Station Capacity Upgrade consultation
- Summer 2017 Preparation of TWAO documentation
- Summer 2018 Submission of TWA Order
- 2019 Public enquiry
- 2020 Commencement of main construction works
- 2024/25 Station Upgrade complete
