## **Proposed safety improvements at Brecknock Road/Camden Road/York Way junction**

I'm writing to let you know about planned improvements to the highway layout at Camden Road junction with Brecknock Road and York Way.

We plan to improve the pedestrian facilities and road safety at this junction by removing an existing traffic island and providing a kerb build out on Brecknock Road.

Our plans will create more footway space and allow pedestrians to cross the road in one movement. The changes will also help motorists to better position themselves when making the right turn from Brecknock Road onto Camden Road.

We also propose to install Advanced Stop Lines (ASLs) on all approaches, to allow cyclists wait in front of other traffic at lights and make them more visible to motorists.

The carriageway and footway will be renewed, to enhance the overall quality of the junction.

A plan setting out our proposals is attached behind this letter.

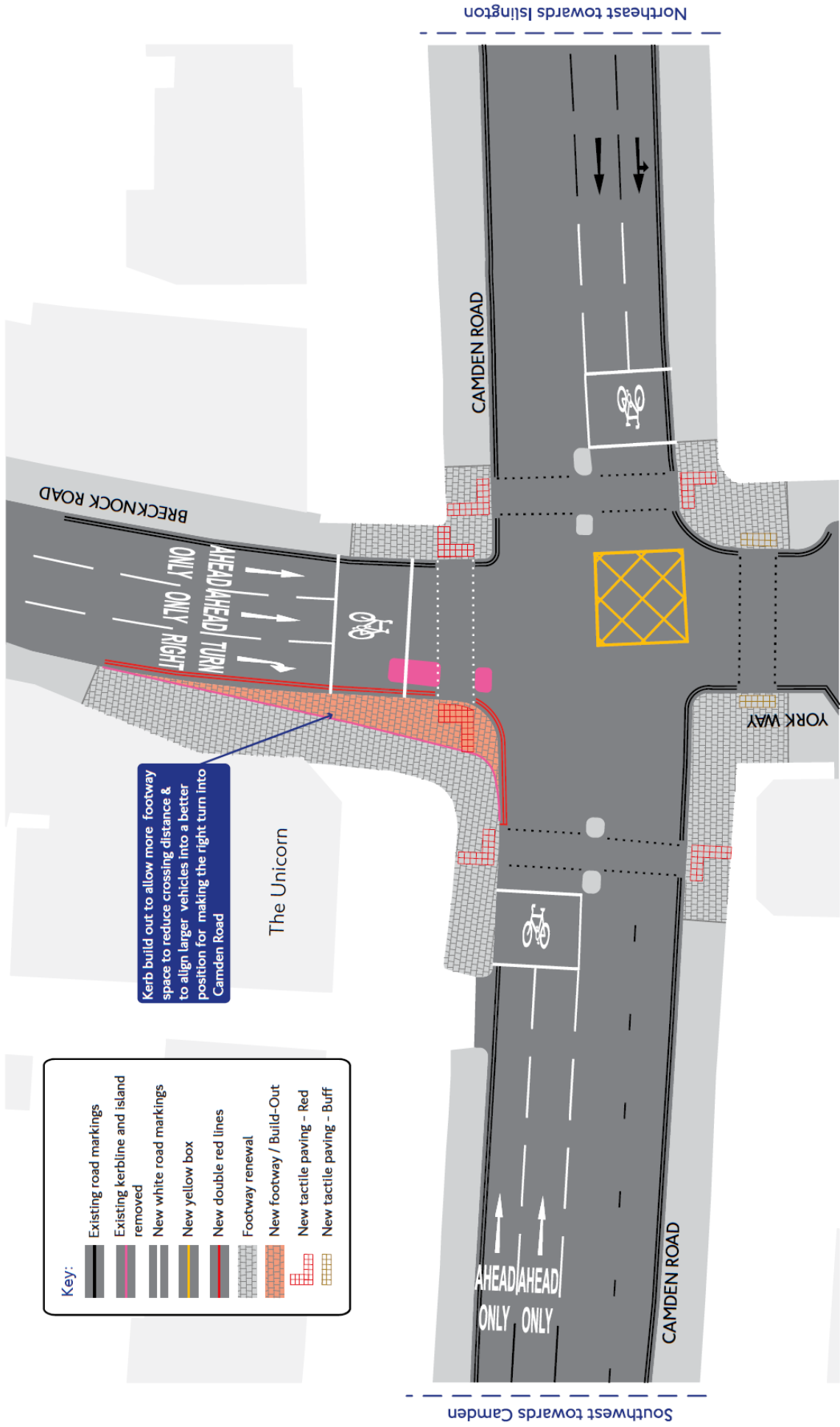
