Re: Donoghue's Waste site, Cricklewood

I am writing following a meeting of Cricklewood residents, Councillors and Barnet Council officers on Monday 11th December. It was established at the meeting that the concrete crushing activities of Donoghue's are not carried out with licence or permission by either the Environment Agency or the Council, due to the machinery being permanently sited onsite.

With this in mind I therefore urge you to take the strongest possible action, and order Donoghue to cease the operation of their concrete crusher immediately.

The impact of this operation on residents has been wholly detrimental to their health and wellbeing. The noise, traffic, congestion and pollution created are unacceptable, especially now that we know it is unpermitted.

Residents have expressed the view that the Environment Agency have not resolved their concerns in a timely or effective manner, and that advice and information keeps changing. In particular it is vital that as much information and data, especially the tonnage figures, are provided to the residents from the audit you recently commissioned.
