## Re: Curzon deal

I am writing to express my objections to your current scheme for Curzon Cinemas to run the Phoenix.

The Phoenix Cinema is an icon of East Finchley, and the whole community rose as one to save it over 30 years ago. The same effort is needed today, thanks to the challenges of local competition, internet streaming services and increasing costs.
