

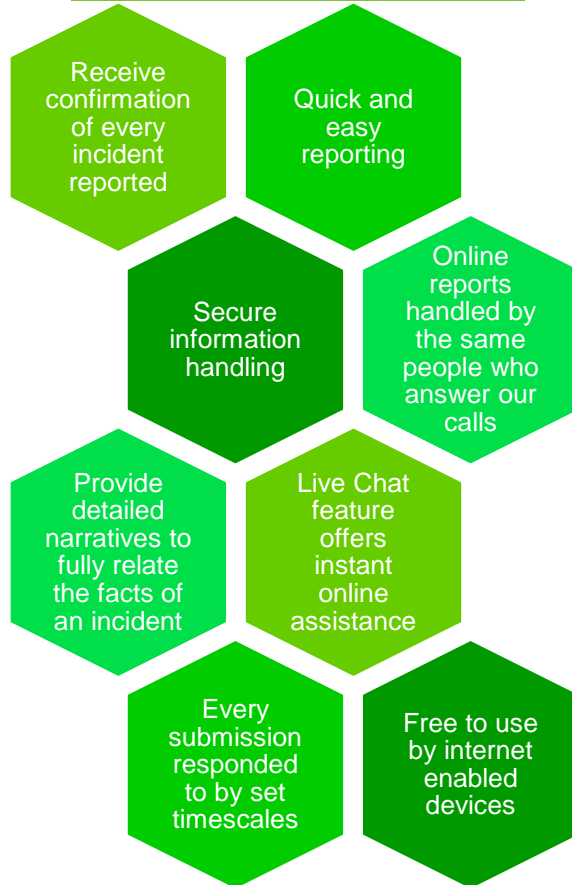

Why Report Non Emergency Crime ...Online?



This guide provides information on where you can find and contact the Met Police via their website to report crime.

In an emergency always call 999. Call 999 when...

A *serious offence* is in progress or has just been committed

Someone is in *immediate* danger

Property is in *immediate* danger of damage

A *serious disruption* to the public is likely

How to Report Crime On The Metropolitan Police Website

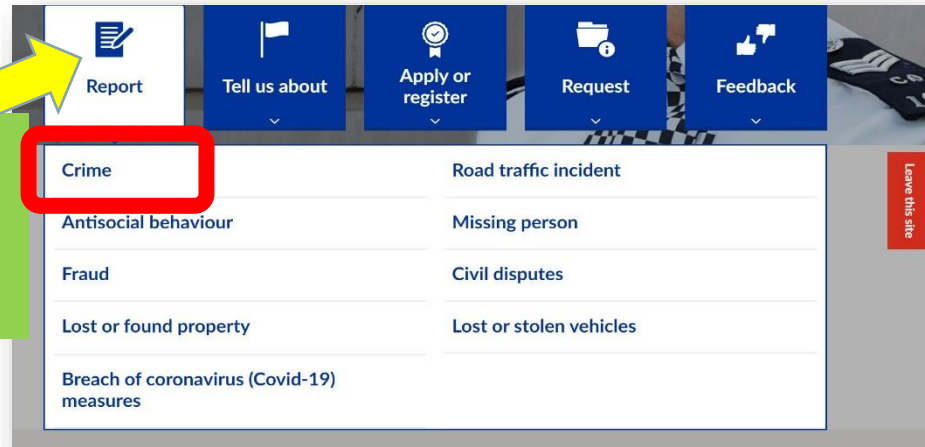


1 Find the Met Police website

Please have the following details ready, if possible:

- the date and time of the crime
- unique details of all items stolen (eg specific marks or colours, a registration number, a phone's IMEI number)
- contact details of anyone who witnessed the crime
- information about any evidence that could help our investigation

Tell us what happened, and add anything you feel could be useful or relevant to an investigation, *include any previous related incidents*

What happened?

Please tell us what happened, and the events leading up to it, to help us identify if an offence has been committed.*

A male came into the shop on his own, took a bottle of wine from the shelf, put it inside a bag he was carrying and then ran out the shop without paying for it.

He dropped his some paperwork he was holding, i have this in a bag at the shop}

He's been in here before taking stuff before without paying for it and we've reported it previously as follows:

01/05/2020 - police ref 12344567/56

02/05/2020 - police ref 11234566/56

3rd May - police cad 4567/03MAY

Once you have completed all the questions and submitted them to us you will be provided with a receipt code.

The receipt code is not a crime reference number.

We will review the information you provided and get back to you using the contact details you provided, either with a crime reference number, or for further guidance.
